LIBRARY

The massive collection of about 1, 23,596 Volumes including very rare texts is the pride of the National College. In addition, the library provides access to 42 Magazines and 105 national as well as international journals in print. In tune with the changing times and technology, the library is completely fully automated and barcoded. The new technology integrated with library automation as well as digital library resources. The WEBOPAC will be launched with mobile customization to access for our Staff and Students.
