- Taking these into consideration, the NCT has framed this Environment and Energy Usage
   Policy and looks forward to its implementation.
- The National College, an autonomous institution of higher learning, under Bharathidasan University, Tiruchirappalli, with local, regional, national and global impacts, routinely evaluates its standards, programmes, practices and special ventures to remain effective.
- The college is eco-friendly in many ways. It is a green campus with lush greenery in the form of lawns, medicinal plants, native boulevard trees and a nursery. Smoking is completely prohibited on campus. Use of poor-quality plastic is also banned. Plastic cups, plastic bottles and plastic bags are not to be thrown inside the campus and violating this rule would invite punishment in the form of fines. Waste is to be segregated into degradable and non-degradable and for their collection two differently painted bins are kept all over the campus. Waste is disposed regularly. A composting unit must be in place to make compost, comprising dead leaves and wasted food. Water conservation is done through rain water harvesting pits in different locations. LED bulbs have to replace the CFL bulbs throughout the campus and help conserve energy. E-waste is to be disposed through agencies that collect and recycle it. A rooftop solar power plant may be erected in future with the money coming from corporate social responsibility. It is hoped that it will save energy and lower the power bills, besides supplying electricity to the local grid. A waste water recycling plant or a Sewage Treatment Plant is to be erected to minimize the dependence on ground water for all watering purposes.

#### Purpose

- The purpose of the Environment and Energy Usage Policy is to create a green campus and inculcate among the teachers and students a green attitude.
- The policy shall serve as an overall framework within which all the stakeholders namely the college management, the teaching staff, the non-teaching staff and the students will act.
