CONSULT ANCY POLICY

This policy aims to encourage faculty members to actively engage in research and consulting projects, while upholding academic integrity and preserving the college's reputation. Faculty members are strongly urged to comply with the guidelines and protocols specified in this policy, conducting research and consulting activities that are in line with the college's mission and values.

Scope: The College aims to offer consultancy services to its clients through the department. These services may encompass various areas such as training, technical support, research projects, and data analysis, among others.

Eligibility Criteria: To be eligible for consultancy projects, faculty members must hold a doctorate in their specialized area. The clients for these projects can be individuals, groups, communities, corporations, companies, governmental agencies, or nonprofit organizations.

Professional Fee: The professional fee for consultancy services will be determined based on factors such as the expertise required, project duration, and resources needed. The fee structure will be discussed and agreed upon with the client on a case-by-case basis. Typically, the consultant receives 60% of the fee, while the institution receives 40%.

Guidelines for Faculty:

Consultancy Agreements: Faculty members interested in offering consultancy work should have a written agreement with the client, outlining the scope of work, deliverables, timelines, and compensation.

Conflict of Interest: Faculty members must disclose any potential conflicts of interest arising from their consulting work, including financial or personal ties with the client. If the consulting work interferes with their duties to the college or poses a risk to the institution's reputation, the college reserves the right to reject it.

Intellectual Property: Faculty members should ensure that any intellectual property resulting from their research or consulting work is protected and appropriately credited. If the college provides significant resources or support, it may claim a portion of the intellectual property rights.

Reporting: Faculty members are required to report on their research and consulting projects to the Deanery of Research. This report should include the findings, impact, and any publications or presentations related to the study or consulting work.

Faculty members are expected to follow the guidelines and procedures outlined in this policy.
