Dear Reader,

I am happy to inform you that many students with high marks in plus two examinations have joined our college in the year 2007-2008. Many activities, curricular and co-curricular, that took

place in the last academic year and the improvement in the infrastructure in the college in the recent years must have made the parents to choose our college to admit their wards. The publicity given by the management through the cable TV and newspaper and the introduction of co-education pattern are notable reasons for the improvement in the quality of the students admitted.

Many teachers have submitted proposals to various sponsoring agencies seeking financial assistance for minor and major projects and for conducting seminars and workshops. Research papers of our teachers have also been published in reputed journals. One of the teachers, from the Department of Chemistry, has gone to the Netherlands under BOYSCAST fellowship for post-doctoral research. Many teachers participated in seminars and workshops and presented papers. All these activities go to show the research bent of mind of our staff.

A Faculty Development Programme on "Soft Skills" conducted on 31st Aug and 1st Sep 2007 was well attended by teachers and requests for such programmes in future have been made by them.

Efforts are being taken to improve the pass percentage of students in university examinations by conducting remedial coaching classes. A study centre has been established with a set of books for the benefit of students who prepare for competitive examinations. The centre would also give room for students studying after college hours. Coaching classes for SC\ST students appearing for competitive examinations and remedial classes for SC\ST students are being conducted regularly. A music teacher has been employed part-time to train our students in keyboard and drums. Music instruments worth Rs.30,000/- have already been procured.

To generate interest in the extra-curricular activities, the college plans to introduce annual NACOFEST (National College Festival) from this academic year and the first of its kind will be held in February 2008.

Our college website www.nct.ac.in has already been launched and the official launching would take place shortly. Browsers can view the website. Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) submitted to NAAC will be uploaded in our college website soon. Suggestions to improve the website are invited.

Workshops/ Seminars /Orientation Programmes

Regional Seminar on "Social Relevance of the Philosophy of Saint Ramalingam"

A one day Regional Seminar on "Social Relevance of the Philosophy of Saint Ramalingam" was organized by the Department of Philosophy on 1st August, 2007. Dr.R.Balasubramanian , Head, Department of Philosophy, welcomed the gathering. The Seminar was presided over by the Principal Dr.K.Anbarasu. Prof.Dr.G.Baskaran, Registrar, Tamil University, Thanjavur, delivered the Key-Note Address. He exhorted the students to cultivate moral values and good habits for peaceful and healthy living.

Dr.S.N.Kandaswamy, former Professor of Tamil, Annamalai, Malaysian and Tamil Universities inaugurated the seminar and presided over the I session. He spoke on the relevance of the philosophy of Saint. Ramalingam and wanted people to follow his tenets for abiding world peace. The presentation was lucid, informative and interesting.



Presiding over the II session, Dr.S.Sathiyaseelan, former Principal, Urumu Dhanalakshmi College, Trichy spoke on the significance of the philosophy of Vallalar and also interacted with students and staff members on several points of social relevance of the Philosophy of Saint Ramalingam. The Reader and Head of the Department Dr.M.N.Abubacker spoke on "Ornamental Garden" Prof.S.Kamala on "Hydroponics" Dr.V.Kannan spoke on "Horticulture Techniques", Dr.B.Muthukumar on "Test Tube Plants" Dr.S.Saravanan on "Herbal Garden" Dr.T.V.Nandagopalan on "Vegetable Garden" and Dr.E.Natarajan on "Vermiculture". The lecture series was followed by field demonstrations on horticulture techniques. Principal Dr.K.Anbarasu, presided over the workshop and distributed the certificates to the participants. Sri.V.Chakrapani, Member, College Committee, National College, while offering felicitation, wanted the department to popularize among the public the need for improving the area of tree cover. He also wanted to curb indiscriminate expansion of cities which destroyed the arable fields. Dr.V.T.Sridharan former HOD, Department of Botany, also offered felicitation.



Orientation Programme on "Geosciences"

An orientation Programme sponsored by Tamilnadu State Council for Science and Technology on "Geo Sciences" for School Teachers was held from 05.09.2007 to 07.09.2007. Dr.V.Radhakrishnan Registrar, Bharathidasan University, Tiruchirapalli inaugurated the programme. In his inaugural address, Dr.V.Radhakrishnan appreciated the efforts of the



Department of Geology, National College, Tiruchirapalli in popularizing the subject. He narrated the importance of geology in disaster management, mineral and fuel exploration, water resource management etc. 30 teachers from various schools in Tiruchirapalli District participated in the programme. There were 10 lecture sessions covering different topics of Earth Science. A field -cum- instructional trip to the places of geological interest around Ariyalur was also conducted to show the participants the occurrence of fossils in sedimentary formations. In his valedictory address, Thiru. Thangaiah, Chief Educational Officer, Tiruchirapalli stressed the need for the awareness of Geo Sciences among the students of Primary, Secondary and Higher Secondary classes.

Faculty Development Programme on Soft Skills

A two-day faculty development programme on "Soft Skills" was organized exclusively for the members of the teaching staff in both Aided and Unaided sections of our college. It was held on 31st August and 1st September 2007. The programme was inaugurated by Dr.V.B.Athreya, Professor and Head, Department of Economics, Bharathidasan University. He enthralled the audience by his straight talk on the present educational scenario. Sri.V.Chakarapani, Member College Committee offered felicitations. Many well known soft skill trainers, communication experts and motivational



speakers like Prof.Jayakar Chellaraj, Prof.Panchanadham, Dr.K.Boominathan, Prof.S.Sunder, Dr.Jayanthasri Balakrishnan, Prof.Garnet Fernandez and Mr.Prahalad Bharathan, HRD Manager, SCOPE International engaged the teachers in meaningful dialogues and explained the nuances of Soft Skills. Prof.R.Panchanadham spoke on the subject

'Be a Professional". He regaled the audience with many humourous anecdotal references from his career. Prof. Jayakar Chellaraj discussed how teaching could transform the lives of students and teachers themselves. According to him, leading an impactful life matters most for a teacher. Prof. Jayakar touched upon communication skills and value systems that determine the success rate of a teacher. Dr.V.K.Boominathan, in his own inimitable style, appealed to the audience to be sincere in their efforts when they play the role as classroom managers. Prof.S.Sundar enlightened the audience about the industry's expectations of students. He explained how the market forces determine the quality of students and not the institutions. Prof. Garnet Fernandez stressed the importance of character building and how it helps in our interpersonal relationships. He asked the audience to be alert towards signals of friendship and antagonism. Dr. Jayanthasri Balakrishnan spoke on "Placement Blues." She made an impassioned plea for total dedication to student welfare. She narrated her experience as motivator and how it helped many socially and economically backward student to find placement in good companies. Mr.Prahalad Bharathan gave a first hand account of the recruitment policies and procedures of his company, SCOPE international. He narrated his own struggle and how he moved up in the career ladder. Many teachers, in their feed back, expressed the need for such periodical programmes.

Sliver Jubilee Function of Zoology Department

The Department of Zoology celebrated its Silver Jubilee during 26-28th September 2007. On 26.09.2007, the day of inauguration, Mrs.Sarubala R.Thondaiman, the Mayor of Tiruchirapalli, in her inaugural speech expressed her pleasant surprise over the grand scale of Silver Jubilee celebrations. She also expressed her concern about the protection of endangered species. She released the first copy of the "Jubilee Souvenir" and the College Secretary Mr.K.Raghunathan received it. While delivering the presidential address Dr.K.Anbarasu, Principal, discussed in detail the causes and effects of the ongoing climatic changes. He pointed out that mitigation was possible only with the active participation of every individual in the society.

On the 2nd day (27.09.2007) two special lectures, one in the forenoon session by Dr.M.A.Akbarsha, Head Department of Animal Science, Bharathidasan University, Tiruchirapalli, on "Obesity epidemics of 21st century" and the other in the afternoon session on "Sea-level changes" by Dr.K.Anbarasu, Principal, National College, were delivered. Meanwhile, researchers presented papers on themes like environmental management, bio-technology and biodiversity. The papers evoked scholarly discussions.

On the last day (28.09.2007) our Vice-Principal Prof. A.Krishnamoorthy delivered an encouraging address and cheered up the large gathering.

Chemistry Association

The satellite data can be a major input in analyzing Geological and Geomorphological details under the GIS environment, he added. Dr.K.Anbarasu, Principal of the College, presided over the meeting. He noted how the integration of GPS and Satellite data would give safe transportation facilities in cities. He wanted the students to learn GIS software as it would fetch them good jobs at the end of their degree programme. Earlier, Dr.V.Kumar, Reader and Head, Department of Geology, welcomed the gathering. Dr.V.Vasanthamohan, Vice-President, Geology Association, National College, proposed the Vote of Thanks.

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Mathematics Association
