We have added two more feathers in our cap during this semester. The NAAC (National Assessment and Accreditation Council) has re-accredited our college with 'A' Grade for the next five years. The UGC (University Grants Commission) has recognized our college as **College with Potential for Excellence**. We could **achieve both** these distinctions due to the tireless efforts and dedicated hard work put in by the Principal and all the Teachers.

Economics Department

Golden Jubilee Celebrations & State Level Seminar on Money & Banking

As part of the Golden Jubilee Celebrations of the Department of Economics, a One Day State Level Seminar was organized on **Money and Banking** on 30-09-2011. Prof.S.X.Prabu, Head, Department of Economics welcomed the scholars and dignitaries during the inaugural function. In his presidential address, Principal Dr.K.Anbarasu talked of a multi-dimensional approach to tackle black money and corruption which are inter-linked.



The Chief Guest **Mr.S.Gurumurthy**, All India Co-convenor, **Swedeshi Jagaran** Manch in his Special Address on **Black Money: It's sources and Impact on Indian Economy**, gave an elaborate account on the history of black money, its sources, causes, effects, implications and its impact on our nation's economy. He spoke about the nature of non-banking money and how various countries apply different criteria to deal with this parallel economy. He said, in recent years, there was a huge increase in the deposit of black money with banks, which are regarded as safe havens, in foreign locations. If this money were to be redeemed, India would turn into an affluent nation and most taxes could be easily withdrawn, Moreover, infrastructure development and rural development would gain renewed momentum. Endowment Lectures

Principal Saranathan Memorial Endowment Lecture

Principal Saranathan Memorial Endowment Lecture, instituted by Sri.M.S.Parthasarathy, was inaugurated and delivered by his son **Dr.Prasannan Parthasarathi, Department of History, Boston College, Massachusetts, U.S.A** on 05-07-2011. He spoke on **Indian Cotton and the World**.

In a vivid portrayal, **Dr.Prasannan** brought out the predominant role of Indian cotton in the global trade during 1600 1800. Cotton accounted for 80% of the world fibre, the remaining 20% Contributed by wool.

He highlighted how Indian cotton found its way into European, South East Asian, Japanese as well as North American markets.



Through a power point presentation, Dr. Prasannan showed elegant pieces of cotton cloth of Indian origin, found in foreign homes and museums. The patterns included duck designs, floral as well as ornate designs. One piece of cloth showed even the Rama-Ravana battle scene.

Dr.K.Anbarasu, Principal welcomed the gathering. He gave an account of how Sri. M.S. Parthasarathi's grandfather identified Principal Saranathan's intelligence during an inspection of a school at Thirunelveli where he was the Inspector of Schools then. After learning the economic background of Saranathan, he took care of Saranathan by keeping him in his house. So Sri.M.S. Parthasarathi's Father and Saranathan grew in the same house and Principal Saranathan was a mentor for Sri. M.S. Parthasarathi. With this background briefing Sri. M.S. Parthasarathi instituted the endowment. Prof.S.Kailasam introduced the Chief Guest. Prof. A. Krishnamoorthy, Controller of Examinations, proposed the vote of thanks.

Medical coding and Job Opportunities. He explained about medical transcription, medical billing, training and placements. He highlighted the importance of CPT (Current Procedural terminology) and ICD (International classification of diseases). The meeting was presided over by Dr.K.Anbarasu, Principal. In his address, he mentioned how internet technology was helpful for medical transcription and coding. Chemistry Association

The Chief Guest **Dr.P.Venuvanalingam**, Professor & Head, Department of Chemistry, Bharathidasan University, Tiruchirappalli delivered a Lecture on **Is the chemical bond a fact or a fiction?** He explained the concept of chemical bond starting from ancient philosophy with different interesting atomic theories as the concepts of a chemical bond have eventually led to the idea of molecular structure and reactivity. He said, "Chemistry is vital to all sciences and



This is a credit mainly to the bonding theory". He concluded that although the existence of the chemical bond was real, the representation of the bond may be fictitious and therefore the scientific research in chemical bond still continued. Dr.K.Anbarasu, Principal presided over the Meeting. Earlier Prof. K. Lakshmanan, Head of the Department welcomed the gathering and introduced the Chief Guest. Mr. M.Dinesh Kumar, II M.Sc. Chemistry proposed the vote of thanks.

The Chemistry Association organised its second meeting on 11.10.2011. The chief guest **Dr.N.Kalaiselvi, Scientist, Central Electrochemical Research Institute, Karaikudi** delivered a Lecture on **Lithium batteries for Green Environment.** In her lecture, she explained the importance of Secondary lithium or lithium- ion batteries and the performance of a cathode material. She described the significance of the research involved in the identification, synthesis and designing of suitable and newer cathode in compatibility mode.



She also pointed out some specific examples such as spinal, layered and olivine cathodes and selected methods of synthesis and analysis. She concluded that when greener energy solutions were practiced for day to day energy and fuel related requirements, the environmental pollution could be prevented to a large extent. Dr.K.Anbarasu, Principal presided over the meeting. Prof.K.Lakshmanan, Head of the Department welcomed the gathering. Mr.M.Dinesh Kumar, II M.Sc. Chemistry proposed the vote of thanks.

The Chemistry Association organized its third meeting on 12.10.2011. The Chief Guest **Dr.K.P.Elango, Associate Professor in Chemistry, Gandhigram Rural -Deemed University, Gandhigram, Dindigal** delivered a special lecture on **Fluoride Toxicity.** The Chief Guest in his speech explained the effects of increase in fluoride concentration on environment. He emphasized that only 0.8 to 1.5 mg/1 of fluoride, which has beneficial effect on their tooth and bone structure, is required for humans and other animals He pointed out that the ingestion of excessive



fluoride, mainly through drinking water causes dental and skeletal fluorosis. He explained the different methods used to eliminate excess fluoride from intake of drinking water. He enlightened the audience on the effect of seasonal variations on the prevalence of fluoride in select blocks of Tamilnadu. Dr.K.Anbarasu, Principal presided over the meeting. Prof.K.Lakshmanan, Head of Department welcomed the gathering. Mr.M. Dinesh Kumar of II M.Sc Chemistry proposed the vote of thanks.

Commerce Association

The activities of Commerce Association were inaugurated on 11-08-2011 by **Dr.R.Khader Mohideen, Principal, Jamal Mohamed College, Trichy**.
